Dear Parents/Carers,

Friday 12th July – Saturday 13th July: Camp.

We recognise that this is your child's last performance at Robert Miles Infants and therefore, to try and accommodate as many parents as possible, will be holding two opportunities for parents to come and watch our end of year performance (please just attend one performance).

Our Year 2 children will be having a very special leaving assembly on **Thursday 25th July at 9am** and we are inviting parents along to this. Please can we kindly ask that only 2 adults attend for each child, to ensure we have enough space in the hall.

Transition to Juniors
